

TCS Behavior Philosophy

Rules, directions, guidelines, and instructions are all an integral part of Christian education. God is a God of order (*I Corinthians 14:33*), mercy (*Numbers 14:18*), justice (*I John 1:9*), and love (*I John 4:8*). In His perfect love and by His matchless mercy He disciplines those He loves (*Hebrews 12:5-6*) because He knows that proper chastisement brings about God-glorifying fruit (*Hebrews 12:11*).

We at TCS strive for that graceful balance between order, mercy, justice, and love, because our positions of authority have been granted to us by God for raising-up the next generation of Christians and instructing them in the ways of God (*Romans 13:1-5*). When a student's behavior counters our instruction or core values then we must immediately, effectively, directly, and lovingly correct the student as to (1) stop the offense, (2) prevent others from acting in a similar manner, and (3) initiate change in the heart and mind of the student. This approach will closely mimic or borrow from the principles of pure, biblical counseling (*Romans 15:14, Colossians 3:16*). The heart of our behavioral management plan is to move the mentality of our students from submitting to a system of rules and regulations to a lifestyle of honoring God via wise choices and voluntarily following His ways with his/her heart, mind, soul, and strength.


