Relationships; Resources and Support; School Environment and Facilities; and Strategic Plan for School Improvement.



26 beginning at 8:00 am. The PSAT/NMSQT test is a great way for students to enter into the National Merit Scholarship Program. It is also a great opportunity to practice standardized testing. It is going to be administered digitally this year, with content areas in Reading. Writing, and Math. The test takes approximately three hours to administer including breaks. Students will be allowed to check out at the conclusion of the test. Please make sure your child gets adequate rest the night before the test and that they bring a calculator, their school-issued Chromebook and charger, a snack, and water on test day.
