Dual Credit Enrollment Policy (updated March 2024)

Dual credit classes require significant student responsibility and academic dedication, and it is considered a privilege in order to participate in dual credit classes. Dual credit classes can begin in a student's 9th grade year after successfully meeting the following criteria:

- Submitting dual credit interest to the school counselor
- Successful completion of an academic advisory council review
- Maintaining a GPA of 3.5 or above
- Maintaining a satisfactory attendance record
- Receiving at least three teacher recommendations in TCS' teacher screening process
- Passing a college entrance exam (ACT or Accuplacer)

Dual credit students will undergo an academic review each semester to ensure that all criteria are continually met throughout a student's academic career.

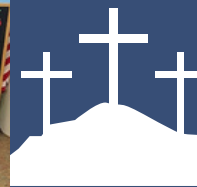


Classroom Celebrations!


